Fulbright Academy – 2004 Annual Report

Major Activities & Developments:

- Developed and upgraded our website. The newsletter was currently sent to around 3,250 individuals worldwide.
- Attended international meetings, including the International Fulbright Conference in Athens, Greece and the annual meeting of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) in Seattle, WA. Given our common interests in advancing science, we anticipate that our involvement with AAAS will increase in future years.
- Organized our first Fulbright Forums in Cambridge, MA, and Cleveland, OH. The first forum, held at Harvard University, was attended by over 50 Fulbright scholars and friends from New England and also included guests from North Carolina.
- Met with individual alumni and members in Maine, New Hampshire, Massachusetts, and the District of Columbia.
- Held monthly board meetings via conference call – established management policies and organizational objectives for the coming years, including the first draft of a five-year fundraising and development plan.

Revenues - \$16,619:

- Dues – individual and institutional members
- Grants & donations – funds from members, institutions, businesses.

Expenses - \$13,867:

- Public education – our newsletter, forums, and other meetings.
- Institutional advancement – membership solicitation, administration, etc.
